## A study is available for persons with aphasia

The Shirley Ryan AbilityLab is conducting a research study that will help us understand how the timing of transcranial direct current stimulation (tDCS) relative to speech-language therapy can impact language outcomes.

If you should qualify, you will receive the following:

1. 40 minutes of speech-language therapy (5 days a week for 3 weeks)
2. 20 minutes of tDCS or sham (inactive) stimulation

- At least 18 years old
- English-speaking before the stroke
